For the first half of the Autumn term we are going to attempt to master our first 100 high frequency words and/ or to master the next 200 high frequency words.

At the end of each week 10 words, at random, will be drawn from the mild and hot lists- children will have a go at writing the spellings.

*It is important to note that the mild spellings are non-negotiables and the hot are for those who are already confident with mild spellings.

For the subsequent terms children will be given mild, medium, hot or spicy spellings according to where they are with their need and Learning Warrior Challenge.
