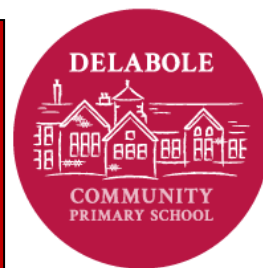

Earth Day

This week as a celebration of Earth Day which took place on 22nd April, Mrs. Cox had the absolute treat of spending an entire day in her natural habitat! From the very start of school, till the final bell, she worked in the hall with each class to create pieces of art for a whole school collaborative sculpture representing our beautiful but fragile Coral Reefs. The children learnt about different creatures and plants which inhabit the reef and then recreated them through a range of media from bubble wrap, to papier mache, and from clay sculpture to painting with dyes. The final pieces will be put together as a collaborative 'reefscape' and every child contributed something. Given that our value this term is Creativity, it was a lovely opportunity to encourage the creative side of each pupil. Thank you to all those parents who contributed materials. It really helped bring diversity to the activities.
