And most importantly, we are now lucky to have, the ever lovely, Mrs Chapman in the office across the whole week. She will be able to help you with any questions, worries or information you might have, need or want to share.

School start and finish times

A reminder that Classes 1, 2 and Foundation start at 8.45am and finish at 3pm. Pam will open the gate at 8.30am and an adult will be in the playground at 8.40am so the children can start on time. Classes 3 & 4 start at 9.00am and finish at 3.15 pm. These times ensure a smooth and prompt start and finish to the day for all children. Early morning learning is often focused on Reading, Phonics our fundamental number work as part of our Recovery Curriculum. Your child is missing vital learning if they are even 5 minutes late.



If children arrive late, the various gates will now be

closed from 9:00am so they will only be able to enter the school via the front entrance. Late arrivals must be recorded on our system for statutory safeguarding responsibilities and are monitored by the Education Welfare Officer so please do encourage children to arrive on time.

Permissions and Information

We will continue to use last year's permissions regarding photo consents, walk home alone authority and collection arrangements. If you would like to make any changes, please contact the office via email on hello@delaboleschool.org

This year we will not be sending out the Data Collection sheets for you to check and return. Therefore, please could you log in to Arbour and check the information we have on file is up to date, if you need to make any amendments please do so.



Meet and Greets

We would like to welcome you in for a class meet and greet in the school where your child's class teacher can share any information about the learning within the class and answer any questions you may have. These have worked really well in the past. These will take place the week beginning 20th September. We will send more details next week when we know the exact date and time for each class.

Swimming

We will begin our swimming lessons week commencing 20th

September. Sometimes daunting but always rewarding, we are really looking forward to all of the children getting back into the pool to develop this essential life skill. Whilst the

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coach company cannot insist on the wearing of face masks on the coach, they have asked if we would kindly consider wearing them. We can supply children with a face mask if necessary. Classes 3 and 4 will need their kit every Tuesday. Classes 1 and 2 will need theirs every Thursday. Foundation Class will be swimming later in the school year.

School Uniform

The children look fantastic in their smart new uniform this week. Thank you. To help us keep control of lost property, please name everything. We will check for named clothing next week. A particular thank you to all those parents who have ensured their children have the correct PE kit and have brought wellies into school.

Water Bottles

We really encourage all children to have access to a school water bottle. The links between good hydration and better learning have been confirmed for many years now. Our school water bottles are available from the school office for £1.75.

It will be busy and productive term and we are really excited to get stuck in and back into a great learning routine.
