Dear parents and carers,

This is the time of year when we begin to really step up the momentum of our end of year celebrations – including our Christmas performance and any community projects/fundraisers. There is a lot to organise so this brief Newsletter is just a brief capture of the key events and dates, so that you can be prepared.

Staffing Update Linked to Recovery Funding

As part of our Recovery Plan for Learning, each school has received a little top up funding in order to set up catch up interventions. These must be used strategically with very focused outcomes for children and we are accountable for showing the impact of any additional provision that is put in place. The Recovery Funding lasts for one year only. In Delabole, we have been fortunate to be able to employ an additional TA daily from lunchtime until end of day. We are therefore delighted to welcome Jenny Flanders to our school. She will be part of the lunchtime team and will then support Class 2 so that Miss Florance – who has been trained as our Read Write Inc intervention TA – can support the Year 2 and Year 1 children in preparation for their phonic screening tests. These are the children who have missed so much of their early phonics and reading development due to lockdowns, so we feel this will make a huge difference in enabling them to close the gap to where they need to be by end of year.

We have also purchased the Fresh Start programme for KS2 children who are struggling to achieve fluency and accuracy in their reading as this is a priority for Secondary readiness and accessing the rest of the curriculum confidently. This will be rolled out from January and your child's class teacher will talk to you if they are part of this programme.

Christmas Cards

Preparations are underway for our Christmas Performances. These will – of course – be very different this year as there will be no live performances in school. That said, we are very keen to continue the important traditions and milestones that mean so much to our children so we would like to reassure parents that there will be a digital offering from each class very much similar to our Harvest celebrations, with Mrs Dickinson's class taking centre stage with the Nativity. Each of the other classes will contribute a poem on Seesaw and on our Website. There may even be a little Christmas offering from the staff so watch out for some much-needed festive cheer.

Christmas Lunch/Christmas Jumper Day

This will take place on Thursday 17th December. Children must wear their school uniform on this day but are invited to wear a Christmas Jumper instead of their school sweatshirt. We are asking for donations of £1 which will go to the Cornwall Air Ambulance appeal.

On the afternoon of Friday 18th December, we will host children's parties, but these will be confined to their class bubbles. We would like children to come into school wearing their party clothes and there will be party food and games.
